#### 2. Provincial Assessment Results

EGLA – grade 2, grade 2 FI, grade 3FI - Our 2 English Prime is 75.45% overall. 2FI 66.85%, 3FI is incorrect due to an error with the inputting of results.

Grade 4 Reading Assessment – huge gains were seen – 68.8 % in Liverpool with 55.3% in province overall.

Grade 4 Science Assessment – 70% Liverpool 73% in province overall

Grade 5 French Immersion Reading – FI Reading results we feel were low for a few reasons – the class sizes are quite full with 27 students, there was a lack of support in FI classes but hopeful to see this improve this school year where our AST is now bilingual and is offering support, as well as there is not a lot of French reading practice happening at home for many reasons.

Grade 5 Mathematics – huge gains were seen and we were above the provincial median – this was due to extra adult support and our SIP goal of mental math focus and working on the basics to get all students confident with their math skills.

3. **Extracurricular Events**- Drama, Glee Club, Ally Club, Soccer intramurals, Reading Club. Bronwyn asked if there was a way that we can communicate with parents which clubs are happening so that they can be aware & help their child join or take part. Mme. Parks will add these to the weekly messages she sends out on Friday.

### **Business Arising from the Minutes:**

Bronwyn spoke on the FI reading results regarding parents reading at home and the change from year to year from Joli Joli to bringing French books home. She told us that at times it is challenging with books to know exactly what is supposed to be read/for it to sound like versus the Joli Joli reads aloud to you. Mme. Parks thanked Bronwyn for sharing her concerns as a parent and went through the FI program with reading and encouraged parents to reach out to their teachers if they have any questions and said any support at home is so beneficial.

Erica asked about the concert happening in December and was wondering if it will be named a Winter Concert vs. Christmas Concert due to the vastness of culture in our school. Mme. Parks said last year was a Winter Concert and every year it will be named as such.
